One of the most beneficial programs for a baby with Down Syndrome is an early intervention program. Typically, a team of professionals work together to train both parents and infant to enhance their baby's development, and the earlier the program is administered can make a big difference for their baby. The different types of programs may include physical therapy, occupational therapy, beech and language therapy, parent training and individual and family support.

During this time of pandemic, parents may still attend these programs so that their family can benefit from the support and information that they can get from experienced professionals as well as from interaction with other parents of children with Down Syndrome who share the same concerns.
