
In terms of <u>Medical service</u> development for Down's syndrome, name 2 services that are a <u>top priority</u> to be developed in your region in the next 2-4 years:

- Adult Downs health assessment and follow up, coordination of care in remote areas


In terms of **Early intervention and Rehabilitation**, name two service aspects that are **a top priority** to be developed in your region in the next 2-4 years:

- 12. Speech therapy, behaviour therapy


How is the diagnosis of Down syndrome confirmed in your country?




Is there a Down syndrome clinic in your country?



Do you have standard guidelines for follow up in your own country?




Do you follow standard international guidelines for Follow up?




Are annual health checks offered to children with Down syndrome?


Are there adult clinics for persons with Down syndrome in your country?




Are there mental health services for persons with intellectual disability available in your country?






Rehabilitation services: Which age group do you have services for?
